We would like to welcome everyone to the 2011 season. Enclosed is our 2011 sales yard price list. This list is intended for the wholesale trade only and supersedes any other pricelist.

TERMS

Cash upon delivery unless credit is established prior to purchase. All credit purchases must be paid by the 25th of the following month. 1 ½% (18% per annum) on accounts not paid within the above terms.

GUARANTEE

We guarantee to sell healthy, true to name stock. We will not assume any responsibility once the plants have left the nursery.

TAGGING OF PLANT MATERIAL

All material tagged will be dated when tagged. Material that is not picked up within one week that has not been paid for will have the tag removed, no exceptions.

RETURNED CHECKS

A charge of \$30.00 per returned check will be charged. Two or more checks returned per year will result in a cash only status.

OVERDUE ACCOUNTS

Overdue accounts will be placed on a C.O.D basis until cleared.

DELIVERY POLICY

A delivery service is available. All deliveries are tailgate only. Customers are required to provide equipment and/or labor force to unload.

RETURNED MERCHANDISE

Any returned merchandise is subject to a restocking charge of 20% of the price billed. **NURSERY STOCK (PLANTS) ARE NOT RETURNABLE NO EXCEPTIONS.**

ATTENTION LANDSCAPERS!!

Please **DO NOT** send your customer to pick up or inspect nursery stock unless you plan to accompany them. Due to machinery and trucks in the yard we recommend children and animals (dogs) remain in your vehicle. Thank you.

If you need to pick up at times other than normal hours please call first to arrange a time.

Customers must properly tarp loads when applicable; we will assist you if we can. Mesh type canvas is recommended. **DO NOT** use plastic blue or green tarps, these tarps hold in heat and do not breathe, they will slap against the foliage damaging the plant. We sell the proper mesh canvas.

Bilmar Nurseries is located in Zone 5. Zone 3 and 4 plants should not experience hardiness problems. Zone 5 plants may exhibit problems in winters where temperatures are often below -20F. We do sell some Zone 6 plants. Care should be used with these plants.

CONTAINER SIZING

The sizing of plant containers in the nursery industry is a total sham. One gallon pots do not hold 1 gallon of soil, etc. In general, but not always, our sizing is based on the following:

“Classic” container numbers with other equivalents:

DEER REPELLENT

For many years we have been using *Thiram* in various formulations as a deer repellent with good results when applied correctly. Recent liquid *Thiram* formulations have not been labeled for animal repellent thus making it illegal to use them for such applications. A new product called *Defiant*, consisting of 75% *Thiram*, in what I would call minute granules, has worked very well for us in back-pack applications. We use warm water in the winter although this does not seem to be totally necessary. Our procedure is to put water in the sprayer, and then mix chemical with water in a wide mouth jar with lid so that it can be agitated by shaking. We then put it in a sprayer, add sticker (*Transfilm*) and further mix with high velocity water. We have used lesser amounts than suggested for our own economy, but we would think a landscaper would want to use the product as recommended. Possible negative aspects are a whitish film on the plants that would take new growth to totally cover. We do not sell this product, but can tell you where to buy it. In the last two winters the deer have eaten plants that they have never eaten before (Douglas Fir & PJM Rhododendron). WE ARE NOW AGGRESSIVELY FENCING OUR PROPERTIES
